The Strawberry Hill Stud Heath Harris Horsemanship Award is John Singleton's ode to a good mate. For those riders who have more than one thoroughbred in their team – for those who have spent countless hours retraining loads of thoroughbreds – this award is a testament to your dedication to training, your tenacity and your love for the thoroughbred horses.

Strawberry Hill Stud will be presenting the Heath Harris Horsemanship award to the showjumping horse and rider combination with the most showjumping wins from Group 3 upwards – including the Puissance and the Six Bar. You can nominate up to 3 horses per rider for this award.

Criteria:

1. The Heath Harris Horsemanship Award will be awarded to the showjumping horse and rider combination with the highest number of showjumping wins overall.
2. Only Group 3, Group 2, Group 1, 6Bar and Puissance classes will count towards each competitor's overall number of wins. Eligible classes are J1, J2, J3, J7, J8, J10, J16 and J18.
3. Must be the same horse and rider combination
4. Apprentice, Maiden, Slipper classes, Maiden Teams and Racing Teams events are not included.
5. Any additional classes you enter other than those listed in point 2 above and point number 24 in the Nomination Conditions will not count towards a competitor's total number of wins.
6. You cannot exceed the maximum number of starts per day allowed
7. In the event of an equal number of wins, the next highest placings will be counted. For example, if three competitors are equal on three wins a piece then the rider with the highest number of second placings will be awarded the Medal and prizemoney.

As well as creating The Hawkesbury River Saddle Company I am so blessed that Heath has left an amazing legacy in Stonewall Equestrian. This is a thoroughbred only competition and all horses competing at this show must have a TSHA licence.

NB. The only 2 classes where a horse doesn't have to have a TSHA licence are the OTT -NSW/ACT led & ridden series classes.

Horses can compete in this class without a TSHA licence but WILL NOT be eligible for any other classes or championships if they do not have a TSHA licence

- To be eligible for a TSHA licence your thoroughbred must be registered with the Australian Thoroughbred Stud Book (your horse does not have to have raced or trialled). No part bred thoroughbreds will be eligible.

 - c. FEI Code of Conduct for Jumping Warm Up Arenas
 - d. EA Code of Conduct
 - e. Australian Helmet Standards
- 2 Australian Helmet Standards will apply.** All riders must wear riding boots and an approved helmet at all times whilst mounted, including presentations.
- 3 All riders competing at the event will be deemed to have read and accepted the Conditions of Entry,** as evidenced by ticking the Agree Box prior to completion of your entry on Global Entries Online.
- 4 After any fall anywhere at Stonewall,** the rider must be cleared by the Medical Services Provider BEFORE re-mounting.
- 5 The OC reserves the right to change or amend the program, conditions, regulations, or any aspect of the event as they see fit.**
- 6 The OC reserves the right to accept or refuse any entry.**
- 7 The OC reserves the right to swab horses** as per EA & FEI rules & regulations
- 8 All owners and competitors will be personally responsible for damages to any third parties caused by themselves, their employees, their agents or their animals.**
- 9 All riders and owners must be financial members of EA to compete in official classes (showjumping 1.05m and over; all dressage is unofficial).** All horses competing in official Classes must hold current EA registration and performance cards. Riders may be required to present horse registration/performance cards upon request of the committee.
- 10 Dogs & Prams**
 - i. Dogs must be on a lead at all times
 - ii. Dogs and prams are not allowed in the warm up or competition arenas
- 11 GST** - is included in all fees and charges and Prizemoney.
- 12 Showjumping Prizemoney** - All showjumping prizemoney will be paid via direct debit within 14 days of the show. Banking slips will be awarded for each class at presentations and it is your responsibility to complete your banking details and hand in all slips to the show office before you leave the grounds.
- 13 Dressage and Show Horse Prizemoney** - all prizes will be awarded on the day at presentations
- 14 Entry Changes**
 - a. Are allowed at no charge via Live Editing
 - b. Will incur a \$10 fee if made outside Live Editing hours and must be made at the office.
- 15 Refunds:**
 - a. Refunds will be given in full before close of entries, less a \$10 administration fee, please contact the OC as refunds are not done automatically.
 - b. After entries have closed, a 50% refund will be given on presentation of a veterinary or doctor's certificate.
 - c. NO refunds will be issued once the event has commenced.
- 16 Presentation of Prizes -**
 - a. Showjumping Presentations in Prydes Easifeed Grass Arena will be held immediately following the event and will always be mounted. Riders are expected to wear their jackets.
 - b. Showjumping Presentations in Inglis Ring 2 will be at the discretion of the OC.
 - c. Dressage presentations will be held at Davali Thoroughbreds Arena following the conclusion of all classes in each level of competition. Dressage presentations will be mounted and you are expected to wear full riding attire including jackets
 - d. Show Horse presentations will be held just outside the Kristen Buchanan Racing Arena for all winners immediately following every event. Where a sponsor is sponsoring multiple classes we do not need to photograph every class winner but will require at least 1 presentation photo for each sponsor. Please follow the directions of the steward and OC
 - e. Anyone who does not present at presentation may forfeit all prize money. If a rider is not available for presentations due to extenuating circumstances, a substitute must be found.
 - f. Riders with stallions or a difficult horse that are placed in a class should substitute this horse for another horse for the presentation
- 17 Number of Showjumping Starts**
 - a. A horse and rider can only enter in **ONE TOUR**
 - b. A horse and rider can only enter **ONE GRAND PRIX CLASS**
 - c. A horse can have ONE start per day (6 Bar, Puissance & Teams events are exempt from this rule)
 - d. No HC entries allowed. Only 1 round per horse per class
- 18 Maximum number of showjumping starts per rider** - no rider will be permitted more than three (3) horse/entries in a class.
- 19 Showjumping Tours run under block entry format**
You can only enter one tour. Each individual tour consists of the following classes:
 - Group 3 Tour - J1 Friday 18th & J8 Grand Prix Saturday 19/11/22
 - Group 2 Tour - J2 Friday 18th & J16 Grand Prix Sunday 20/11/22
 - Group 1 Tour - J3 Friday 18th & J10 Grand Prix Saturday 19/11/22
 - Apprentice Tour - J4 Friday 18th & J19 Grand Prix Sunday 20/11/22
 - Maiden Grand Prix Tour - J5 Fri 18th & J20 Grand Prix Sun 20/11/22

c. Rider and/or handler names must be correct (it is easy to set up multiple rider names in Global entries)
d. If an entry is incorrect at Close of Entries, an admin fee of \$20 per incorrect entry will be incurred. **This includes incorrect horse/rider names/combinations**

- Slipper Tour - J6 on Friday 18th & J11 Grand Prix Saturday 19/11/22
Classes J7, J12 -J15, J18 and J21-J22 are not included in the tours and can be entered separately

- 20 Draw Order for Showjumping** – Prydes Easifeed Grass Arena 1 will follow draw order. Should a horse need to be moved down the draw for exceptional reasons or due to clashes with show horse and/or dressage classes, the marshal shall communicate with the Judge to allow this. Inglis Grass Arena 2 will be whiteboard.
- 21 Apprentice showjumping** class – Horse and/or rider cannot compete higher than the Maiden Tour (80cm) at this show (6 Bar & Puissance excepted).
- 22 Maiden showjumping** class – Horse and/or rider cannot compete higher than Slipper Tour (90-95cm) at this show (6 Bar and Puissance excepted).
- 23 National Showjumping Champion Pointscores.** Each horse & rider combination will be allocated points according to their result in each round of the Tour/Title. There will be two rounds in total that count towards each National Champion:
- Group 3 Tour - J1 Friday 18th & J8 Grand Prix Saturday 19/11/22
 - Group 2 Tour - J2 Friday 18th & J16 Grand Prix Sunday 20/11/22
 - Group 1 Tour - J3 Friday 18th & J10 Grand Prix Saturday 19/11/22
 - Apprentice Tour - J4 Friday 18th & J19 Grand Prix Sunday 20/11/22
 - Maiden Grand Prix Tour - J5 Friday 18th & J20 Grand Prix Sunday 20/11/22
 - Slipper Tour - J6 on Friday 18th & J11 Grand Prix Saturday 19/11/22
- a. First place starter is allocated as many points as there are starters, plus one (1), in descending order to the last placed starter who is allocated one (1) point for the Round. For example, in a class with 30 starters, first placed will be allocated 31 points, second place 29 points, third place 28 and so on, down to the last placed starter who is allocated 1 point.
 - b. Points from the Grand Prix round for each Title will be awarded as in (a) but x 1.5 points
 - c. First place starter is allocated as many points as there are starters, plus one (1), in descending order to the last placed starter who is allocated one (1) point for the Round. For example, in a class with 30 starters, first placed will be allocated 31 points, second place 29 points, third place 28 and so on, down to the last placed starter who is allocated 1 point

 - f. Equality of points: If there are competitors on equal first for points at the conclusion of the two rounds, the National Title will be awarded to the competitor (of those on overall equal first points) who placed highest in the Grand Prix
- 24 Heath Harris Horsemanship Medal.**
- a. The Heath Harris Horsemanship Awards will be awarded to the showjumping horse and rider combination with the highest number of showjump wins overall.
 - b. Only Group 3, Group 2 & Group 1 Tours & 6Bar and Puissance classes will count towards each competitor's overall number of wins. Eligible classes are J1, J2, J3, J7, J8, J10, J16 and J18.
 - c. Apprentice, Maiden, Slipper classes and Maiden Teams and Racing Teams events are not included.
 - d. Any additional classes you enter will not count towards a competitor's total number of wins.
 - e. You cannot exceed the maximum number of starts per day allowed
 - f. In the event of an equal number of wins, the next highest placings will be counted. For example, if three competitors are equal on three wins a piece then the rider with the highest
- 25 All led and ridden show horse exhibitors** must be able to produce an official measurement certificate if required.
- 26 Newcomers Showing** Classes: Horses competing in the Newcomer classes must not have competed under saddle at any show/competition (except racing) prior to 1st January 2021. Due to Covid and for this show only the date will be January 2021 (not January 2022). Must be ridden in a snaffle.
- 27 Novice Showing** - one that has never won a first prize at an open or agricultural or OTT show in a similar class.
- 28 Amateur Owner Rider Rule** - Horses must be owned by the rider or an immediate family member (mother, father, brother, sister, grandmother, grandfather). An amateur cannot have derived income from equestrian pursuits such as teaching and horse training in the past 3 years. Prizemoney and reimbursements paid for volunteer work are not considered income
- 29 No Stallions allowed** in the Show Horse Classes
- 30 Horse and Rider Age for showing** - where this is a condition of a class, the age of the person is on the day of the event and the age of the horse is the preceding 1st August.
- 31 OTT SERIES – see below for additional entry conditions**
- 32 Dressage – Maximum 2 starts per horse.** All Dressage is unofficial. Bridle numbers are required. Callers are permitted for all classes
- 33 Dressage Draws** will be on Global Entries, Facebook & emailed.
- Complaints And Protests**
- All complaints or protests in any way related to the event, whether valid or not, will not be considered by the Organising Committee unless they are presented in legible writing, accompanied by \$50 and duly signed by a single clearly identified person. Protests must be received within 15 minutes of the completion of the class. When a letter is being presented on behalf of a group, it is that group's responsibility to nominate a person to sign it on their behalf. - The event is open to all thoroughbreds that have officially raced or trailed locally, nationally or internationally. All horses are required to be 3 years & over and over 14.2hh. All horses will be registered with a recognized studbook eg: Aust. Studbook/NZ Studbook/Irish Studbook. As determined by Racing Victoria in July 2018, a separate OTT category is to include horses that are Stud Book registered but have not trailed or raced. It is up to individual show societies to clarify these classes in the schedule. Racing name to be used. OTT Qualifying class/es will be judged as a led and ridden class. Led and Ridden are two different series. Once a qualifier has been won, the horse cannot compete in other qualifiers within the season. Horses that have achieved Runner Up are able to continue in the competition unless they win an OTT Qualifier class. The winner and runner up of each qualifying class will be eligible to compete in the State Final. Winners will be posted on the FB page. Horses will be judged as a good example of a Thoroughbred rather than riding horse/hunter types with the following being taken into consideration.
- Thoroughbred qualities,
 - Conformation
 - Manners, paces and performance
 - Injuries caused through racing such as blemishes are allowed
- Judges decision is final in qualifiers and final. Horse and Owner must reside in NSW or ACT to compete in the Off the Track NSW/ACT Series.
